What you'll need		When to use it
	Glass jar [pint, quart, gallon]	To store dried herbs, to make herbal medicines
٥	Amber/blue loz-2oz bottles + partner dropper tops [dropper, spray, pump tops]	Best to store finished herbal medicines in dark bottles to assure longer shelf life
	Wax paper	Place between lid + jar of all herbal medicines
٥	Various funnels	To transfer finished medicine to amber bottles, transfer herbs into glass jars
۵	Cheesecloth or nut milk bag	Used to strain remove plant material from finished medicines
	Various strainers	Used to strain plant material
	Mixing bowls	To support mixing of dried herbs + straining medicines
۵	Measuring cups	To support exact measurements of menstrums/herbs or act as a funnel when necessary
	Measuring spoons	To support exact measurements of menstrums/herns
	Mortar & Pestle	To grind herbs into powder or smaller forms
	Grinder	To grind roots and barks into powders
	Kitchen scale	To measure out specific quantities of dried herbs
	Sauce pans	To make herbal syrups, honeys + decoctions
	Cutting boards	To cut herbs/roots
	Knives	To cut fresh herbs/roots
	Foraging bag	To collect plant ancestors from the wild
۵	Pocket knife/hand clippers/pruning shears	To harvest parts of plants + branches; hand clippers are recommended for tougher plants
	Scissors	To cut fresh herbs for medicine preparation
	Labels or light colored masking tape	To document when/how/where we made our medicine
	1 to 2 inch 3 ring binder	Collect plant observations, profiles + learnings
	Pencils, pens, colored pencils, watercolor	To support our learning + creation!
